In his speech, European Union Ambassador to the UAE HE Mr. Patrizio Fondi confirmed that Europe is ready for more cooperation with the UAE and the Arab region to achieve the sustainable development and address regional and international crises

The Ambassador saluted Dr. Abu-Ghazaleh as a friend through many years of mutual work in serving other countries.

The seminar was attended by a host of ambassadors and businessmen who highly appreciated the theme and objectives of the seminar.
